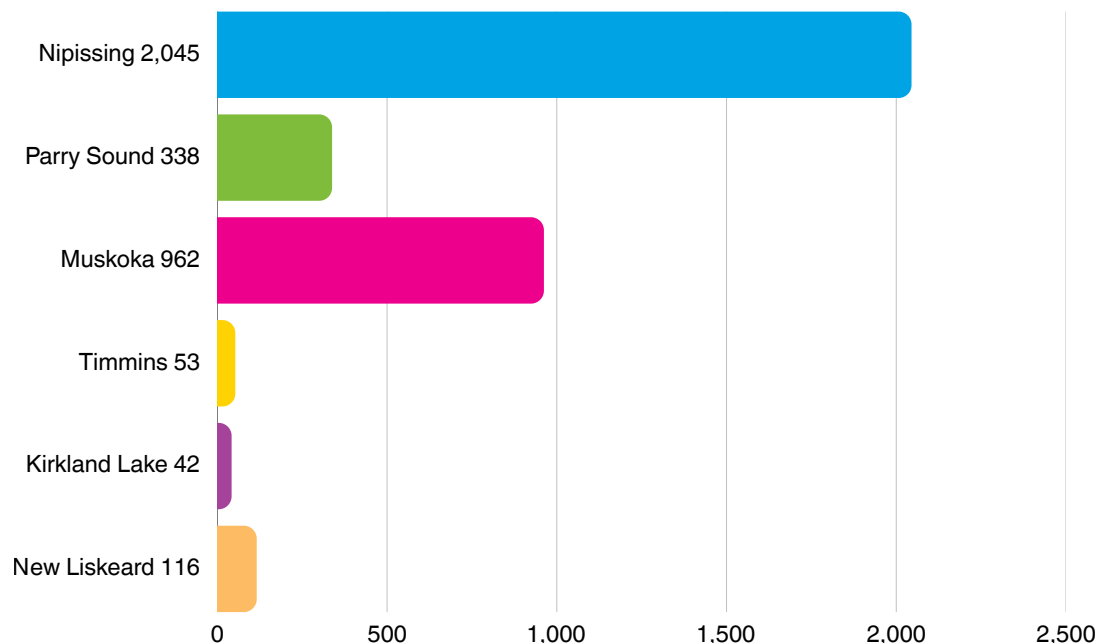

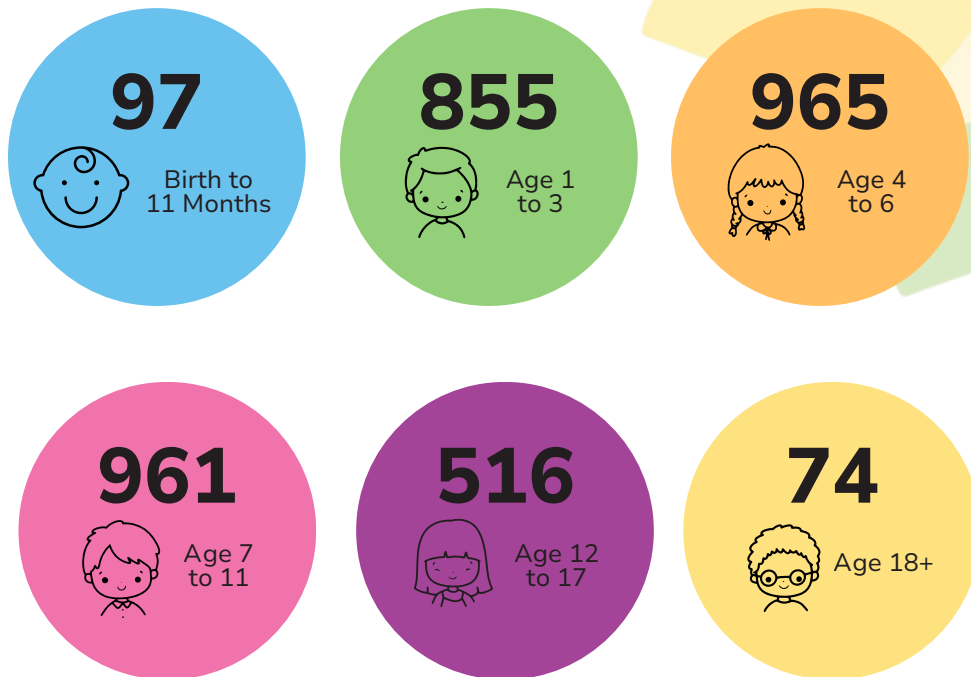

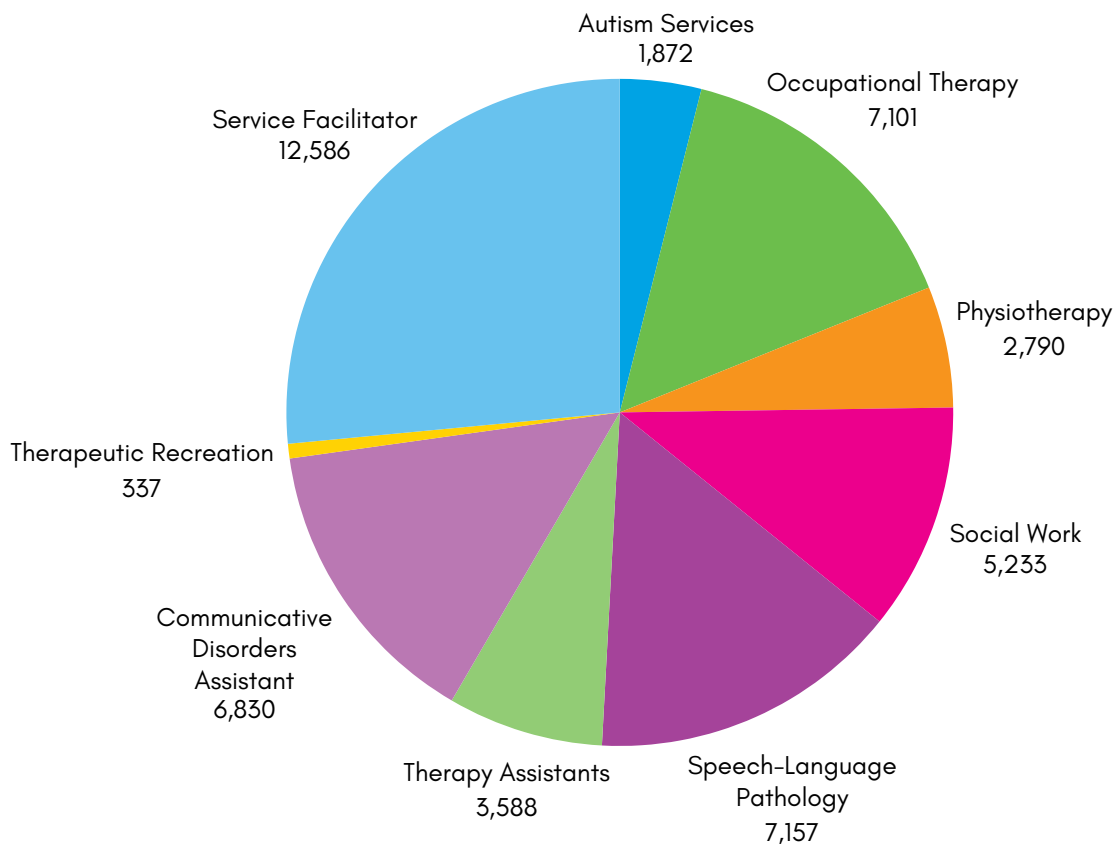
Children & Youth Served by District

Building Understanding Creating Opportunities

One Kids Place understands that receiving an Autism diagnosis can bring a wide range of emotions, relief, uncertainty, worry, and even fear. For many families, determining the next steps and understanding available supports can feel overwhelming and confusing.

Our goal is to ensure that no family has to navigate this journey alone.

Autism is a lifelong developmental condition that affects how a person communicates, interacts with others, and experiences the world around them. Every autistic child is unique, bringing their own individual strengths, perspectives, and challenges. At One Kids Place, our Autism Services team delivers a uniquely multidisciplinary approach that is tailored to meet the specific needs of each child and family. Through collaboration across our clinical teams, we develop individualized care plans that support growth, independence, participation, and meaningful outcomes for children and youth.

Our team is here when families have questions about assessments, funding opportunities, community resources, or available programs, to help make the process easier to understand and navigate. By providing personalized support, we ensure families feel informed, empowered, and connected to the services they need.

We also provide Behaviour Services for children and youth who may be engaging in challenging behaviours or who require support in developing new skills. These services are supervised by Registered Behaviour Analysts and focus on creating positive, individualized strategies that help children and youth succeed at home, at school, and in their community.

Our teams continue to work closely with families, caregivers, educators, and community partners to foster supportive environments where children and youth can thrive.

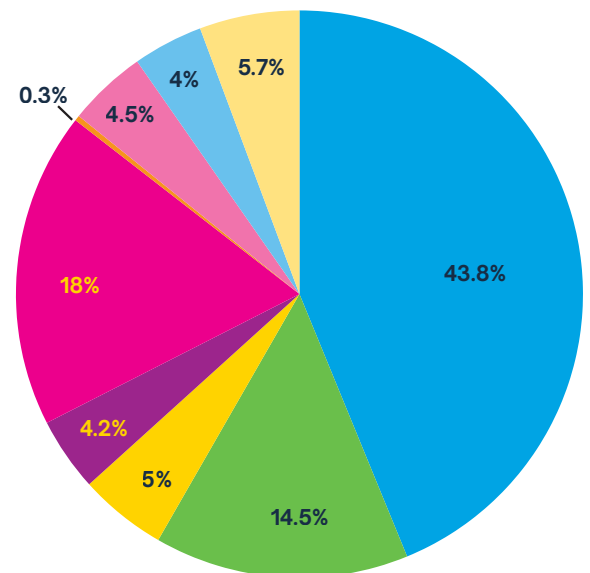
